## **VADEMECUM UNISG LIBRARY**

The Library of the University of Gastronomic Sciences is located in the Agenzia di Pollenzo in Piazza Vittorio Emanuele, 9 Fraction Pollenzo - 12042 Bra (Cn), on the 2nd Floor.

For the acquisition of print resources available at the library, the procedure is as follows:

- Log on to www.librinlinea.it (Portal for the member libraries of Piedmont)
- Click on "Ricerca avanzata";
- On the "Ricerca avanzata" page, enter the desired search criteria, and click on the "Dove" section on the "Singola Biblioteca" and clicking in the drop-down menu, on the University of Gastronomic Sciences;
- Click "Cerca".

All newly-enrolled students at the University are provided a username and password, activated by General Services (servizi generali@unisg.it) upon arrival, and must use these to access all journals to which the University subscribes.

## **For finding online resources**, the procedure is as follows:

- Log on to the Library homepage <a href="http://www.unisg.it/en/campus/library/">http://www.unisg.it/en/campus/library/</a>;
- Click on the "Discover the UNISG Online Resources" login button;
- Insert your username and password provided to you by the General Services office;
- To search in all databases and resources available at UNISG, click <u>Catalog</u> <u>Discovery</u> Service di EBSCO;
- Click on "New Search";
- Enter the desired keywords and click "Search".

All students are invited to the annual **online resources presentation**, at which several experts will be available to explain in more detail how to perform bibliography searches, which are especially useful to prepare for study trips and the final thesis. The date of this presentation will be announced by mail, and the official presentation announcement will be available on the University website.
