



## **REGULATIONS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL COURSE ON PIEDMONTESE WINES**

This document outlines the regulations for participation in the University of Gastronomic Sciences' International Course on Piedmontese Wines.

Upon receiving the official letter of acceptance from the Program Coordinator, course participants are required to transmit an administrative fee of €100 to confirm their participation. The fee should be paid by February 5, 2010 and wired to the following account:

The fee is non-refundable in the event that the participant withdraws.

Participation in the course is free. The course consists of lessons and tastings held at the university campus, as well as site visits to wineries within the region. Participants will be provided with all necessary study materials.

All lessons will be translated into those languages previously announced.

Participants in the course are offered accommodation and meals during the period of the program at the Hotel of the Agenzia di Pollenzo and at the various hosting sites. Accommodation at the Hotel of the Agenzia is not all-inclusive, therefore all extras, including dinner during the free evening as programmed, are excluded.

On check-out days, the program coordinators will arrange for ground transfers from Pollenzo to Torino.

The course is open only to wine-sector professionals. Participants who intend to bring a guest not registered in the course must make separate and private arrangements with the Hotel. Participants must provide the Hotel with their credit card number and expiration date. Any cancellations must be made 72 hours prior to the start of lessons, otherwise the credit card on file will be charged the full amount of the reservation.



Registration in the course does not include any kind of medical insurance. Non-EU participants are strongly encouraged to make their own arrangements for coverage.

The University of Gastronomic Sciences reserves the right to cancel the course in the event that a minimum number of participants are not enrolled, as well as for other reasons. In the event of a cancellation, registered participants will be reimbursed the administrative fee of €100. In the event of a cancellations, the university will not be held responsible for any other expenses incurred by the participant.

Participants' personal and private information will be handled according to Italian and European law.
