### PAYMENT OF UNIVERSITY FEES

2009-2010 Academic Year

#### **THREE-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM**

The total University fees are €13,000 per year.

The following additional fees are charged to students requiring accommodation and use of the Restaurant Service

- Student Lodging: +€5,000/year
- Restaurant: +€1,000/year

University fees must be paid in two installments:

- first installment: no later than September 15, 2009
- second installment: no later than March 31, 2010

Fee exemptions are granted each year to students whose income and merit requirements apply to the “Fee Exemption Rights Awarding and Merit-Based Loan Regulations” and to the provisions stated each year in the official announcements approved by the UNISG Administrative Board.

The following fee exemptions will be granted for the 2009-2010 academic year the University.

Non-European students<sup>1</sup>:

- 4 fee exemptions of €13,000 each
- 2 fee exemptions of €10,000 each
- 2 fee exemptions of €5,000 each

Italian students who have passed the May 2009 admission test to the first year of the three-year undergraduate program, and who wish to enroll, must pay a deposit of €2,000 by June 30, 2009. If students decide not to complete the enrollment procedure, they are entitled to a reimbursement of

€1,600 only if their decision is communicated no later than August 31, 2009. No reimbursement will be made after that date.

Students having the income requirements stated in the official announcement, who apply for a university fee exemption and, following the announcement of successful candidates, are not among the fee-exemption recipients, and decide not to complete their enrollment procedure, will be returned the €2,000 deposit in full.

Italian students who have passed the May 2009 admission test, and are enrolled in the first year of the three-year undergraduate program, can deduct the €2,000 deposit paid by June 30, 2009 from the first installment amount (see table above).

Students who pay in advance and in full the university fee amount (please refer to above-options) upon the September 30, 2009 deadline will receive a fee reduction of €250.

**Students who have not paid their tuition fees in full will be not allowed to take exams, participate in stages, or use Student Lodging and the Restaurant Service.**

### **Third-year students graduating after the end of the third year of the program**

Third-year students who, at the end of the third year of the the program, have not yet graduated (i.e. have exams to take and/or their thesis to present after the February 2010 extra examination session), will be required to pay a **€2,000** fee.

Should these students continue to need accommodation in Student Lodging, they will also have to pay:

- €1,000 for accommodation until October 31, 2009
- €2,500 for accommodation until December 31, 2009
- €4,000 for accommodation until February 28, 2010
- €5,000 for accommodation until September 30, 2010.

### **PAYMENT EXTENSIONS**

#### Art. 7.7 of the Student regulations and course enrollment

Any delay in the deadlines for paying the university fee installments must be requested in writing to the university director. The relevant form can be downloaded from the Intranet website

<http://dida.unisg.it>, no later than the deadline of the fee installment. Under no circumstance will requests for delayed payments exceeding 90 days from the fee payment deadline will be accepted. Delay applications submitted according to the above procedure will be considered by the university director, whose decision is final.

## **GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM**

### **Students enrolled in the first year of the two-year graduate program:**

The total University fees are €13,000 per year.

The following additional fees are charged to students requiring accommodation and/or use of the Restaurant Service

- Student Lodging: +€4,000 per year. The accommodation period covers the Pollenzo-campus academic calendar, i.e. excluding the study-abroad periods
- Restaurant service: +€1,000 per year.

University fees must be paid in two installments:

- first installment: no later than October 31, 2009
- second installment: no later than March 31, 2010

Fee exemptions are granted each year to students whose income and merit requirements apply to the “Fee Exemption Rights Awarding and Merit-Based Loan Regulations” and to the provisions stated each year in the official announcements approved by the UNISG Administrative Board.

EU students holders or non-holders of a fee exemption, can apply for a merit-based loan at Banca Intesa San Paolo (<https://www.intesabridge.it>).

4 fee exemptions of €9,000 each will be granted to EU and non-EU students for the 2009-2010 academic year.

Students who pay in advance and in full the university fee amount (please refer to above-options) upon the October 31, 2009 deadline will receive a fee reduction of €250.

**Students enrolled in the second year of the two-year graduate program**

The total University fees are €13,000 per year.

The following additional fees are charged to students requiring accommodation and use of the Restaurant Service

- Student Lodging: +€3,000/year, during the on-campus academic calendar, i.e. excluding the internship and study-abroad periods
- Restaurant Service: + €600/year during these same periods.

University fees must be paid in two installments:

- first installment: no later than September 15, 2009
- second installment: no later than March 31, 2010

**Second-year students graduating after the closing date of the second academic year**

Second-year students who, at the end of the second year of the program have not yet graduated, i.e. have exams to take and/or their thesis to present after the February 2010 extra examination session), will be required to pay a **€2,000** fee.

Should these students continue to need accommodation in Student Lodging, they will also have to pay:

- €1,000 for accommodation until October 31, 2010
- €2,500 for accommodation until December 31, 2010
- €4,000 for accommodation until February 28, 2011
- €5,000 for accommodation until September 30, 2011

## **AMOUNTS TO BE PAID BY STUDENTS TRANSFERRED FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES**

To transfer from another Italian university to the University of Gastronomic Sciences, students must obtain a transfer certificate from the previous institution, stating the number of credits earned for passed examinations. The Faculty Board will decide on the validation of the candidate's previous academic career, and on his or her future academic progress. Once obtained a positive evaluation from the Faculty Board, the student can carry out the enrollment procedure, after the relative credit-related fees have been paid.

Credit-related fees can be paid in two installments:

- 50% at the time the enrollment fee is paid
- 50% by June 30 of the relevant academic year
