  - you do not belong to a notoriously high-income, high-social status family.
- the scholarship application form (*Attachment 4*).

Please indicate in the object of the email "Scholarship application, a.y. 2025/2026\_Name of the Program". Documents must be sent readable and in pdf or word format.

The completed scholarship application must arrive in digital format by the deadline indicated on the scholarship public announcement.

The University can request further documentation to control the truthfulness of the documentation submitted.

## STEP 2 - Publication of the Scholarship Ranking list

The final list of students awarded fee exemptions will be published on the University's website (www.unisg.it) on the date indicated in the scholarship announcement.
