ART. 1 – WHO CAN APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

Students can apply if:

- they are citizens from low-income countries or lower middle income or upper middle-income countries according to the World Bank¹
- they have applied during the first or second admission session (March or June 2024). **The candidate who at the date of publication of the March 25, 2024 early admission results decides to apply for a UNISG scholarship will no longer be eligible for the early bird discount.**
- they are in possession of a **minimum level of English language equivalent to a C1-level**, (in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). The candidate

must complete an online interview with a UNISG professor (use of the webcam required) in order to verify the aforementioned minimum English language requirement;

- whose income and property situation do not exceed the limits indicated above;
- they have been admitted to the Master program for the 2024/2025 academic year with a minimum score of **80/100**;
- they are subsequently enrolled as a regular student in the program (auditors are not eligible to apply).

ART. 2 – WHO CANNOT APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

Students may not apply for a scholarship if:

- they are not regularly enrolled for the academic year for which they are applying;
- their application arrives after the stated deadline (Art. 3);
- they have not provided the required documentation (Attachments 1);
- a family member has already been assigned a UNISG scholarship;
- they have already obtained academic qualifications that are equivalent to or higher than the One-year 1st level Master Degree

ART. 3 – WHEN AND HOW SHOULD I SUBMIT THE APPLICATION?

The applications can be:

- submitted in person to the Registrar Office during business hours
- or
- sent via e-mail to segreteria@unisg.it, indicating in the subject of the email “*Scholarship application a.y. 24/25- Master*”.



Applications must be received by **June 17, 2024**.

The documents sent must be readable, in pdf or word format.

The University may request the original documents in paper form.

Those who have not received a confirmation email within 3 working days after submitting the document are invited to contact the Registrar Office.

ART. 4 – HOW IS THE RANKING DRAWN UP

The ranking of suitable candidates is prepared in descending order on the basis of the admission score.

In case of equal final score, the person from the lower income group² will be awarded the fee exemption.

In case of a further equal score, the youngest candidate will be assigned the fee exemption.

 The ranking will be published on the University Website (www.unisg.it) by **June 24, 2024**.

ART. 5 – WHAT THE EXEMPTION CONSISTS OF AND HOW DO I KEEP IT

Who obtains the total scholarship:

- cannot convert these benefits into cash values owed
- must meet the merit requirements to keep the scholarship (Attachment 2)
- may stay in feature double rooms and mixed gender at the UNISG student apartments
- can benefit from the lunch service at the Academic Tables Dining Hall only on days in which academic activities are scheduled.

Who obtains the partial scholarship:

- does not receive any amount of money;
- must not pay the tuition fee for the amount of the exemption he/she was assigned;
- must meet the merit requirements to keep the scholarship in the second and third year (Attachment 2).

ART. 6 – CHECK OF SELF-CERTIFICATIONS

Check of economic status

The University checks the self-certifications sent in relation to the economic status. The University may request suitable documentation at any time to demonstrate the completeness and truthfulness of the data declared.

Penalties

In case of false declarations, the student will lose:

- the benefits obtained (Art. 75 of Presidential Decree 445/2000),
- the right to obtain other payments for the duration of the study program.

Data processing

Upon submitting their signed self-declaration form, students are informed of European law, Reg.(UE) 2016/679, and Italian legislative Decree n. 196 of 30 June 2003, and subsequent amendments and additions, as well as the provisions of the authority that guarantees protection of personal data.

Students' personal data, which must be provided for the purposes of determining eligibility and assigning scholarships, are processed exclusively for the purposes of managing this announcement and are stored at the University of Gastronomic Sciences – Academic and Registrar Office, with corresponding records kept in digital format. Students who fail to provide said data cannot be
