FEE PAYMENT REGULATIONS

FOR PART-TIME STUDENT ENROLLMENT IN UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES

Academic Year 2023/2024

STUDENTS ENROLLED AS PART-TIME IN THE FIRST YEAR OF DEGREE COURSES IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024

TOTAL FEE

- **6.500 euros per year**



PAYMENT

- **Advance payment - 1000 euro**

Students admitted to the course after the publication/communication of the results (as specified in the Admission Procedures), will have to pay an advance deposit of **1000 euros** within a week from the date of communication of the test result, in order to confirm their enrollment.

- If the candidate is not able to pay the advance deposit within the established deadline, he/she will be excluded from the enrollment ranking list and will have to repeat the entire admission process.
- The admitted candidate who wishes to withdraw from the enrollment after having paid the advance deposit shall be entitled to a refund of 500 euros only upon the presentation of a written communication of withdrawal to the Registrar's Office no later than 31 August 2023. This communication must be accompanied by the relevant bank account details (IBAN) for the reimbursement of the amount. The candidate shall not be entitled to any form of reimbursement of the advance paid if the withdrawal request is presented after the date indicated above.
- Only for candidates enrolling in the undergraduate degree course:* At the time of the enrollment, candidates, who have not successfully passed the state exam to obtain the higher secondary school qualification or lack one of the requirements for enrollment in the first year of the degree course, has the right to a refund of the entire amount of the advance deposit paid.

- **First Installment: 2.500 euros by 30/09/2023**

- **Second Installment: 3.000 euros by 31/03/2024**

EXCERPTS FROM THE REGULATIONS FOR PART-TIME STUDENTS ENROLLMENT

Article 4 –SWITCHING FROM FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT TO PART-TIME ENROLLMENT

4.1 - The switching from full-time enrollment to part-time enrollment (and vice versa) is allowed only once during the university career, except for particular cases, where the committee referred to in article 2 shall evaluate justified and documented requests to take decisions.

Article 5 –CHARACTERISTICS AND DURATION OF THE CURRICULUM

[...]–The specific characteristics of the curriculum in relation to each student will be established on a case-by-case basis by the Committee pursuant to article 2. The academic workload required from the student who chooses the part-time enrollment is equal to 45 credits (except for duly justified exceptions).

Article 6 – FEE STRUCTURE

6.1 – The amount of the annual tuition fee for part-time enrollment and the related payment methods and terms are defined by the Tuition fee Payment Instructions, approved annually by the Executive Committee.

6.2 – Pursuant to article 4, switching back to full-time enrollment require that the student adhere to full-time enrollment fee structure from the moment in which the corresponding request from the student has been accepted without any retroactive effect.
