Candidates ADMITTED earn a point score equal to or greater than 80 in the first admission session are directly admitted.

Candidates IN A WAITING LIST earn a point score between 60 and 79,5 points in the first admission session, and therefore have not been directly admitted, may choose to:

- maintain their current position for the final rankings, to be published within **July 29, 2023** maintaining the point score earned in the first admission session, or:
- re-do the written exam and the online interview in the second admission session, by **July 24, 2023** while maintaining the current score for the dossier.

In this second case, the written exam and online interview scores earned in the first admission session will be cancelled, while the dossier score will remain unchanged.

Candidates who earn a score of less than 60 are not admitted in any session.

Withdrawn candidates, as well as those with incomplete documentation, will also not appear in the rankings list.

In order to know their score, candidates must write to e.fogliotti@unisg.it. Telephone requests are not taken into consideration.

The maximum number of admitted students for the Two-Year Degree Program in Food Innovation and Management is 50 students.

The final ranking will be published by **July 29, 2023**. In the event that one or more candidates among the first 50 do not confirm the enrollment within the established terms, any vacancies will be filled by candidates with position 51 and below based on the score obtained and, in any case, until the maximum number of 50 confirmed students is reached.



The academic year will start on September 18, 2023.

Candidates admitted in the first session to the Graduate Degree program must confirm their position by sending an email to segreteria@unisg.it and by transferring the €2000 deposit **within 7 days of the publication of the results of the first admission session** (Payment Regulations are available [HERE](#)). Payments must be made by bank transfer to the account of UNIVERSITÀ DEGLI STUDI DI SCIENZE GASTRONOMICHE.
