**ART. 1 – WHO CAN APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP**

Students can apply if:

- they have applied during the first, second or third admission session (March, May or July 2026)
- have been admitted to the first year of the Degree Course for the 2026/2027 a.y. with a **minimum admission score of 70/100<sup>1</sup>**;
- whose ISEE (income)/ISPE (property) amounts do not exceed the limits indicated in the table.

**ART. 2 – WHO CANNOT APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP**

Students cannot apply for the scholarship if:

- they have not been admitted to the academic year for which they are applying for a scholarship;
- they have submitted the application after the deadline (Art. 3);
- they have not sent the requested documentation (Attachments 1 or 2);
- they have a family member already awarded a UNISG scholarship;
- they already have a first level Degree (a Bachelor).

**ART. 3 – WHEN AND HOW SHOULD I SUBMIT THE APPLICATION**

The applications must be sent via e-mail to [segreteria@unisg.it](mailto:segreteria@unisg.it), indicating in the subject of the email

*“Scholarship application a.y. 26/27- Undergraduate Degree Course in Food Tech for Ecological Transition”.*



Applications must be received by **21 July 2026**.

The documents sent must be readable, in pdf or word format.

The University may request the original documents in paper form.

Those who have not received a confirmation email within 3 working days after submitting the document are invited to contact the Registrar Office.

<sup>1</sup> Admission scores are based on merit criteria as indicated in the "Admission procedure" document.

#### **ART. 4 – HOW IS THE RANKING DRAWN UP**

The ranking of suitable candidates is prepared in descending order on the basis of the admission score. In case of equal final score, the person with the highest score achieved during the admission interview will benefit from the exemption. In case of a further equal score, the youngest candidate will be assigned the fee exemption.

#### **ART. 5 – WHAT THE EXEMPTION CONSISTS OF AND HOW DO I KEEP IT**

Who obtains the partial or total scholarship:

- does not receive any amount of money;
- must not pay the tuition fee for the amount of the exemption he/she was assigned;
- must meet the merit requirements to keep the scholarship in the second and third year (Attachment 3).

#### **ART. 6 – CHECK OF SELF-CERTIFICATIONS**

##### **Check of economic status**

The University checks the self-certifications sent in relation to the economic status. The University may request suitable documentation at any time to demonstrate the completeness and truthfulness of the data declared.

##### **Penalties**

In case of false declarations, the student will lose:

- the benefits obtained (Art. 75 of Presidential Decree 445/2000),
- the right to obtain other payments for the duration of the study program.

##### **Data processing**

Upon submitting their signed self-declaration form, students are informed of European law, Reg. (UE) 2016/679, and Italian legislative Decree n. 196 of 30 June 2003, and subsequent amendments and additions, as well as the provisions of the authority that guarantees protection of personal data.

Students' personal data, which must be provided for the purposes of determining eligibility and assigning scholarships, are processed exclusively for the purposes of managing this announcement and are stored at the University of Gastronomic Sciences – Academic and Registrar Office, with corresponding records kept in digital format. Students who fail to provide said data cannot be evaluated and will therefore be excluded from the process.

As per the above-mentioned Legislative Decree, candidates may exercise their right to correct, update, complete or erase inaccurate or incomplete data or data collected in violation of current privacy laws.
