DECREE of 15 April 2005

Establishment of the University of Gastronomic Science as a non-state, but legally recognised University, with headquarters in Bra (Cuneo), frazione Pollenzo.

Having seen Ministerial Decree no. 262 dated 5 August 2004, relating to the planning of the University system for the period 2004-2006, registered with the State Auditors' Department on 27 October 2004, register no. 6, sheet no. 177 ;

Having seen article 9 of the above mentioned decree of which paragraph 1 envisages, starting from Academic Year 2004-2005, the establishment of the University of Gastronomic Science as a non-state, but legally recognised University, with headquarters in Pollenzo (Cuneo) (promoter: Associazione amici dell'Università di scienze gastronomiche, Pollenzo), with a degree course in gastronomic science (class 20);

Having seen the above mentioned article 9 of which paragraph 2 envisages that the establishment of Universities specified in paragraph 1 that have the authorisation to issue university qualifications with legal value, together with the authorisation of the University Statute and Teaching Regulation, is implemented with Ministerial Decree;

Having seen the opinion given by the University National Council on the draft university teaching regulation in the last meeting of 14 April 2005, and having seen that it has been amended accordingly;

Decrees:

Art. 1

1. Starting from Academic Year 2004-2005, the University of Gastronomic Science is established as a non-state, but legally recognised University with headquarters in Bra (Cuneo), frazione Pollenzo, with a faculty of gastronomic science and a degree course in gastronomic science (class 20).

Art. 2

1. The University Statute and Teaching Regulation as per art. 1 above and enclosed with this decree are approved; the University is authorised to issue university qualifications with legal value as per the same article.

Art. 3

1. At the end of the third, fifth and seventh Academic Year of activity of the University specified in art. 1, to assess the University system the National Committee shall carry out an assessment of the results achieved, also based on the Annual Report of the University Internal Assessment Team.
2. Only after the Committee's positive assessment at the end of the fifth year of activity, the University will become eligible for the financial contributions envisaged by law no. 243 dated 29 July 1991 and by article 5, paragraph 1, letter c) of law no. 537 dated 24 December 1993, according to the ways specified by the same regulation and in line with the actual availability of resources.
3. Based on the Committee's latest positive assessment, the accreditation can be arranged according to the provisions of article 25 of Ministerial Decree no. 262 dated 5 August 2004. The validity of the accreditation is subject to the Committee's positive assessment of the results achieved every three years.
4. This Decree is sent to the Ministry of Justice for its publication on the Official Journal of the Italian Republic.
